# A letter from the Principal

Dear Sand Lake Families,

I'd like to start by saying thank you for taking time to meet with your child's teacher during 1st Quarter Conferences. Conferences are an important part of what we do, and working together great things will happen at Sand Lake Elementary. Now that conferences are over, please remember to check Q for updated progress summaries for your children.

Daylight savings time happens on November 5th, so it's official, we're heading into winter! As a reminder, please make sure your children are ready for the snow, and that all their gear is labeled. As the temperature drops, it's important your child has gloves, a hat, coat, snow pants, and boots. Not every child wants to wear all of these items each day, so when it's below zero and you don't have gloves, the only option is to borrow what may be available in the nurse's office. Students go outside every day, unless the temperature is colder than -10 degrees F.

Now that it is much darker during the morning commute to school, please make sure your children have something reflective on their winter gear whether they are walking to school or waiting at the bus stop.

Our next PTSA/TNK meeting will be on Thursday, November 9th at 4:00 pm in the library. Moving forward, meetings will alternate between the afternoon and the evening.

Thank you for working together to decrease the number of issues in the parking lot during drop off/pick-up times.
