All students who will be riding bicycles, scooters or wearing roller blades to school this year need to have the following permission form on file in the school office. Please go over the safety items on this form with your child.

I understand that it is my child's responsibility to know the rules and to operate the equipment safely.

In order to help him/her do this, I have read with him/her and understand Sand Lake's policies.

Students are required to have a parent permission form on file in the office. Due to the hazardous streets in our area, we ask that parents assume the responsibility for their child's safety while traveling between school and home on any of the wheeled equipment listed above. Students should only travel on the equipment in good weather. When they do, they need to follow the rules below:

- 1. Only one rider on a bike, scooter or skateboard.
- 2. All equipment must be in safe, working order.
- 3. Know the simple traffic laws and safety rules for bicycle, scooter, skateboard and roller blade travel and obey them.
  - 4. Upon reaching or leaving the school grounds, students must walk. The use of equipment is prohibited on school grounds.
  - 5. All bicycles should be equipped with locks to prevent theft and unauthorized borrowing.
  - **6.** To prevent accidents and other problems, equipment will not be used on the playground.
  - 7. Do not leave equipment at school or on the school grounds over night or on weekends.
  - **8. Kindergarteners need to be accompanied by a parent if they are traveling** on any of the equipment to and from school.
  - **9. Helmets are required.** NO EXCEPTIONS.

Due to aspects of Alaska State Law, elementary students are not to drive motorized vehicles to school at any time. ASD policy also restricts the use of bikes, scooters, skateboards, and roller blades on school grounds during the school day. Students who do not follow the above rules will not be allowed to travel to and from school on their equipment.
