GENERAL (All Grade Levels—Except Pre-school)

<input type="checkbox"/>	Tissue boxes	1 box	Facial tissues, 50-count or larger
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lunch bag	1 each	Lunch bag or box to transport school lunch to/from home
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pencils	1 box	#2 pencils
<input type="checkbox"/>	Crayons	1 box	24 or less
<input type="checkbox"/>	White glue	1 each	School glue, 4-oz bottle

Kindergarten Only

EMERGENCY COMFORT KIT



In the event of a natural disaster or other such emergency, and the need for us to keep students at school longer than the typical day, it would be helpful for each child to have a "Comfort Kit".

The contents and instructions for assembling this kit are listed below. If you have any questions, contact the office. Please send the kit before the end of August. Thank you.

Emergency Comfort Kit Contents—required for all students

- 1 pair mittens or gloves
- 1 pair socks
- 1 warm hat
- 1 pair underwear (for younger students)
- 1 or 2 non-perishable food items (such as breakfast bars, granola bars, crackers---no chocolate, please)
- 1 small plastic bottle of water
- A few Band-Aids

Optional Items:

- A photo of you
- A note to your child

The clothing items need not be new or matching, but they should be clean. Place items in a gallon-size Ziploc bag with the student's name on the bag. Inside the bag, place a piece of paper with your student's name, parents' names and phone numbers, important medical information, and the names of adults to whom your student may be released in the event of an emergency.
