# **Goldenview Classroom Spelling Bee Sheet**

Step 1: Copy and distribute study materials (one week or more before classroom bee)-

- Must be on or before February 7th

- Please note: Students can come to my school-wide practices whether or not they have competed in a classroom bee yet or not.
- In the event that you do not / cannot hold a classroom bee, you can always send me a list of
  interested volunteers to compete. However, to compete in the school-wide bee, students who
  did not compete in a classroom bee must attend at least one practice with me or check in
  with me during first lunch so they can practice/learn proper decorum for the competition.
- If students express a strong interest, send them my way, either way! And, as always, please see me if you have any questions!
