Compared to Middle school, there are many changes to how students sign up for Freshman courses. As always, we will request academic recommendations for the core subjects of Language Arts, Science, Math, & Social Studies from your student's current teachers. Freshmen will sign up for their ELECTIVE course requests electronically through "Q" during a specific time window, March 6th- March 24th. Parents and students will be able to view core class recommendations and edit their elective selections until the end of their course request window by logging into their Student Connect account. Those students who are waiting for the lottery to happen will be given a paper elective form to complete during the online window.

West Counselors will be visiting Romig and Central, our main feeder schools, to introduce West course offerings and have students sign up electronically for elective courses. An information session will also be held on Zoom for students who attend other middle schools or alternative programs. An outline of transition activities is listed below.
