GUIDANCE FOR ELECTRONICALLY SELECTING WEST HIGH SCHOOL FRESHMAN ELECTIVES

Students who were unable to attend the Introduction to West Offerings and Elective Sign up due to COVID-19, may sign up for Freshman Electives at home through "Student Connect-Q" by the directions linked below:

Course request windows have been standardized across the eight comprehensive high schools and the **Freshman window has been extended and is currently open.** Middle school teachers have provided 9th grade core class recommendations. These recommendations are visible in Student Connect Year 20-21. Electives choices are entered <u>by incoming freshman</u> ELECTRONICALLY_through Student Connect. - Log into Q Parent Connect, then select the 2020-2021 track
- o Click the (+) sign next to Requests, located on the left side of the screen
- Note: Parents will not have the ability to edit course selections, this must be done via Student Connection
