### EDUCATIONAL ALLOTMENTS

Family Partnership has the largest educational allotments in Alaska. We know providing your child's education is expensive. Use these allotments to pay for curriculum, private tutors, technology, and many other educational needs. Unspent allotments can be rolled over to the next year.

### CERTIFIED TEACHER SUPPORT

Our certified teachers are here for you! They are the best part of our school, guiding you in your educational decisions. They have knowledge of various curriculums and resources to help your student succeed. ### PART-TIME ENROLLMENT AT ASD SCHOOLS

Because Family Partnership is an Anchorage School District charter school, students can take up to 3 classes at their neighborhood school. Students can enjoy the benefits of attending a public school, while maintaining the freedom and flexibility as a homeschool student. They can participate in ASD school sports, as well as special programs, clubs, activities, and events. The partnership between ASD and Family Partnership allows homeschoolers to enjoy the perks of attending their neighborhood school.

### EARLY COLLEGE PROGRAM

Many of our qualified high schoolers choose to take college courses at universities. Dual enrolled students may enroll in college credit courses and use these courses for high school graduation credit as well as college credit. Students graduate with both ASD high school and college credits. Students may use their allotments to pay for tuition, books, and most fees at postsecondary institutions. We also have a partnership with UAF that allows reduced tuition for students.

### ONLINE CLASSES

With the flexibility of online classes, students can prioritize their time and work at their own pace. Students have opportunities to take specialized classes that may not be available in their area. Family Partnership can provide guidance on finding the right online program for you. We also offer Ox Academy, our own online courses taught by homeschool teachers.

### ENRICHMENT WORKSHOPS

Looking to connect with other homeschoolers? Family Partnership offers virtual and face-to-face classes on specific topics that are difficult to teach in the home including: dissections, experiments, foreign languages, STEM activities, and group book studies. Classes are hands-on "stints of fun" meant to provide a fun environment where homeschoolers can learn and interact with each other.

### FIELD TRIPS

Family Partnership schedules a variety of field trips including: plays, museums, science centers, and local businesses. No need to plan outings. Rely on Family Partnership to provide a schedule of field trips and join other homeschoolers in experiencing real-world learning. We know the Anchorage community is an incredible resource for broadening students' education, sparking passion and curiosity.

### SUPPORT SERVICES

Do you have a student with special needs? Are they gifted? In need of speech classes? While we don't provide services on-site, we can help you access the help you need at your neighborhood school. Our staff serves as a representative, helping you receive the help you need.

### VENDOR SERVICES

Need help finding a music teacher, math tutor, or swimming instructor? Choose from a list of our approved vendors and allow us to bill them directly from your child's educational allotment. Our vendors are a wonderful resource for families looking to provide course options.

### PRIVATE SCHOOLS

If you have a student attending a private school full time, you may be able to access some of our educational avenues. Talk with one of our Sponsor Teachers to discuss the options for maintaining your private school status while being able to use Family Partnership to further enrich their educational experience.

### LIBRARY

Family Partnership offers a free resource library for our families. Want to preview curriculum before purchasing? Looking to save money and borrow resources? We offer access to free materials, along with a parent workstation, so families can prepare to homeschool.
