Kids' Heart Challenge

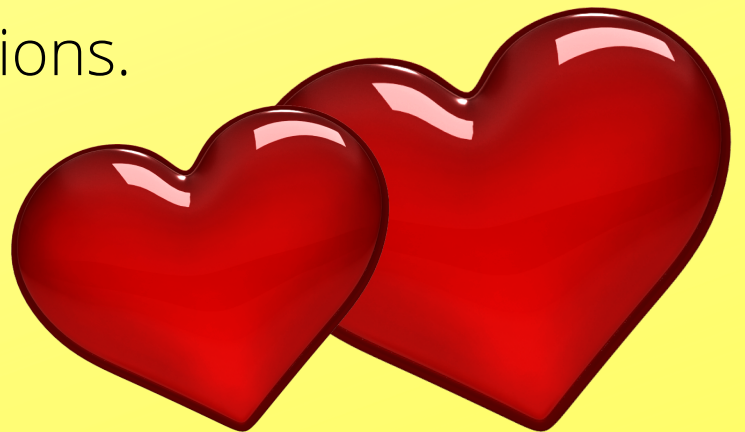
It was Kids' Heart Challenge week in PE this week!
