Student Item Pickup

Every student will have a bag for pick up during the week of May 4th.

These bags will have any personal belongings that have been left behind, student journals, notebooks, art, and other papers to be returned.

Upon arrival, the family identifies themselves to a staff member who radios a team in the building. The building team brings the student belongings outside to a collection table where the family collects the belongings. Any library, textbooks, or Treasure Books being returned by the family will be dropped off in tubs at the curb before the family leaves.

Registration

Returning students can be registered through Q/Zangle ParentConnection from April 27-August 21, 2020

Elementary school offices are scheduled to reopen the week of July 22nd. The schedule for in-person registration for kindergartners will be held as currently planned, but subject to change. The current schedule is:

Tuesday, July 28 - 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM
Wednesday, July 29 - 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM
Thursday, July 30 - 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM

Kindergarten families are required to submit the following documents at registration:

- Proof of Residency (utility bill, lease, or real estate contract, etc.)
- Birth Certificate (copy acceptable)
- Current immunization records
- Current physical and mailing address and phone numbers of students and parents
- Names and phone numbers of emergency contacts and individuals who may pick up the child from school
- Name and address of previous school attended
- Copies of current legal papers if there is a custody agreement

The first day of school:

- August 18, 2020 for Grades 1 – 6
- August 25, 2020 for Kindergarten
