Intensive confirmations for elementary students will be sent home on November 1st. Secondary Intensives will take the place of regular classes as well.

Some of the Intensives cost money, but we don't want that to dissuade you from choosing. Our school works hard to raise scholarship money for students who might need assistance paying for Intensives. Applications are available in the office and are due Thursday, November 8th by 9:00AM.


