Winter Intensives!

Intensives are a wonderful opportunity to learn with other teachers and students. They will take the place of our regular classes from Monday, January 6th through Friday, January 17th. Please read through this catalog and <u>turn in your registration to your family group teacher no later than Tuesday, October 22.</u> All registrations received by the due date will be given equal consideration. Because there are a limited number of spaces in each class, it's necessary to fill out <u>3 separate choices.</u> Please note that students will not be enrolled in an Intensive without a signed registration form. Intensive confirmations for elementary students will be sent home on Thursday, October 31. Secondary Intensives will take the place of regular classes as well.

Some of the Intensives cost money, but we don't want that to dissuade you from choosing. Our school works hard to raise scholarship money for students who might need assistance paying for Intensives. Let your family group teacher know at registration time if you are in need. Scholarship applications are due Friday, November 15 by 8:30 AM in the office.




Mo Willems Intensive

Children's Literature





Karaoke Party

In this intensive students will build reading fluency skills in an engaging way! Students will record their own renditions of karaoke songs and poems throughout the intensive.



Students have the opportunity to write their own songs and poems.

Students will be introduced to a variety of songs and poems, both student and teacher selected. This intensive will explore the context of written song lyrics and poetic rhythm by exploring literary devices such as metaphors, imagery, alliteration, and repetition. We will also discuss the point of view and intended audience. Students will be guided to make connections between listening to song lyrics and reading written poetry. They will gain a greater understanding of how music can be paired with words used as a powerful mode of communicating the writer's ideas, emotions, and stories.
