Anchorage School District Fine Arts COVID Mitigations, Fall 2021 All Fine Arts Classes:

- Masks Required For All Ensembles (Art, Band, Choir, Orchestra, Theater):
- Increased distancing between students (at least 3 feet or greatest extent possible)
- Classroom procedures that limit gatherings in small spaces (i.e. practice rooms,

getting/returning instruments or materials for rehearsal, flow of traffic)

- Hand Washing/sanitizing before and after class
- Enhanced ventilation (open windows where/when possible)
- Disinfect/sanitize shared equipment and room at the end of the day

### Band:

- Follow ensemble spacing guidelines
- Bell Covers for all wind instruments
- Use masks when not playing (percussionists use masks entire class)

### Choir:

Follow ensemble spacing guidelines

• Follow ensemble spacing guidelines

### School Nurse Letter

Hello Parents! Parents/Guardians should continue to conduct a daily symptom screening of their children and keep them home if they have symptoms. Please do not send kids to school if they are symptomatic. Below are the ASD guidelines for unvaccinated and vaccinated students and staff in preparation for our students' return. Per Dr. Bishop's letter sent out on 9/1/21, we will continue to notify parents/guardians if there is a positive contact in school or if your child is a close contact. See covid-19 screening tool for unvaccinated and vaccinated student/staff.

#### **COVID-19 Screening Tool for Unvaccinated People**

- 1) If a student/staff is not vaccinated and tests positive, 10-day isolation is required (can return to school on Day 11).
  - o Symptomatic: Day 0 of quarantine is the 1<sup>st</sup> day that symptoms started
  - o Asymptomatic: Day 0 of quarantine is the 1<sup>st</sup> day you received the test
  - o Wear a mask and monitor symptoms for 14-days since last exposure
- 2) If an unvaccinated student is determined to a close contact with a known positive, a 10-day quarantine is required (can return to school on Day 11). Day 0 is the last day that you were exposed to the positive person or the date of symptom onset, whichever is first. You have the option of receiving a PCR test on or after Day 6. If negative, then you can be released from quarantine on Day 8.
- 3) You are not vaccinated, and you develop symptoms. Below are three options (you only need to do **one** of these options):
  - Receive a negative test
  - o Obtain a doctor's note that states that the symptoms are not COVID related
  - o Isolate for 10-days from the start of symptoms (can return to school on Day 11)

### **COVID-19 Screening Tool for Vaccinated People**

- 1)You have been vaccinated and have contact with a known positive; no quarantine is required if you have no symptoms. However, the CDC recommends getting a COVID test 3-5 days after the last known exposure. This is NOT required at ASD.
  - If you develop symptoms, see #3 below.
  - If you get tested, and it is positive, see #2 below.
  - Wear a mask and monitor symptoms for 14-days since last exposure.
- 2)You have been vaccinated, and you test positive. 10-day isolation is required (can return to school on Day 11).
  - Symptomatic: Day 0 of quarantine is the 1<sup>st</sup> day that symptoms started
  - Asymptomatic: Day 0 of quarantine is the 1<sup>st</sup> day you received the test
  - Wear a mask and monitor symptoms for 14-days since the test was collected
- 3)You have been vaccinated, and you develop symptoms. Below are the three options (you only need to do **one** of these options):
  - Receive a negative test
  - Obtain a doctor note that states that the symptoms are not COVIDrelated
  - Isolate for 10-days from the start of symptoms (can return to school/work on Day 11).


