Pre-Enrollment for New to District students will open again on July 15th 2022.

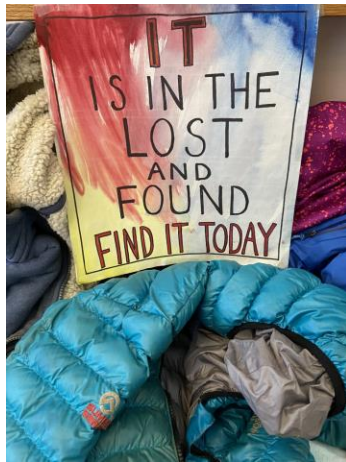
Who is a New-to District Student?

Get your **"Pizza, Popcorn, and Bake Sale Punchcard"** next week! Do you struggle to remember to send your student with cash for pizza (grades 5-8), popcorn, and bake sales offered by the seventh-grade? We get it! We will begin selling punchcards next week.

What: Punchcards for pizza, popcorn and bake sales

Cost: Punchcards will be sold in \$10 increments with ten punches per card. More than one card may be purchased at a time.

How to buy: Punchcards will be available outside the grade seven door between 8:15 and 8:30 Monday to Friday

How to use: Punchcards will be stored in a recipe box and kept secure at school.

Siblings may share a punchcard. Customers simply need to inform the student-seller that they have a punchcard in the box. The seller will find the punchcard and punch the appropriate amount. Pizza slices (for grades 5-8, only) will be two punches per slice, popcorn and baked goods (for sale to all) will be one punch per item. Any remaining punches at the end of the year will be gratefully accepted as a donation to our efforts.

To help you plan for the rest of the year: There are three popcorn/bake sales and three pizza days remaining! Popcorn and bake sales occur on Thursdays. Pizza is for sale on Friday for grades 5-8.

The ordinance (law) passed by the Anchorage Assembly on June 20, 2019 makes it unlawful for a driver of any vehicle to talk on a mobile communication device while driving a vehicle within an active school zone or on school grounds, unless the vehicle is stopped or a hands-free device is used.
