Waldorf-inspired Learning

Our school educates one class per grade K-8, 8:15 am to 3:15 pm with early dismissal every Thursday 8:15 am to 12:30 pm.

Winterberry offers a Kindergarten program 8:15 am to 12:30 pm, Monday-Friday, with an option for after-care until 3:15 pm (excluding Thursdays).

Specialty Classes and Sports

- Handwork: fiber arts, woodworking
- World Languages: Spanish, German, French
- Music: choral singing, pentatonic flute, recorder, potentially strings
- Movement: physical and imaginative play, mindfulness, Native Youth Olympics, folk dance, Pentathlon, Circus arts and performance
- Grade 6-8 cross country running and ski team

Predictable Rhythm

A consistent daily rhythm eases transitions and carries students confidently through their weeks.

Schoolwide seasonal celebrations like the fall Festival of Courage, winter Lantern Walk, Solstice Spiral Walk, and spring Mayfest renew our community with a close connection to the changes in our natural world and to each other.

Connected to Nature

We make maximum use of outside time and fresh air.

- Outdoor Recess: 40 minutes
- Movement Class: outside for 45 minutes two to three days per week
- Nature Walks for K-Grade 3: at least an hour long, once per week through neighboring wooded trails
- Fresh Air: some Specialty Classes and lunch can occur outdoors, at the teacher's discretion

Blended Learning Option – Winterberry Hybrid Program

A dedicated full-time teacher is available to mentor families who wish to use a blended learning model within Winterberry's Waldorf-inspired community through the Hybrid Program.

Families enjoy the expert leadership and guidance of an experienced Waldorf Hybrid teacher. Children K-8 have the option of attending class in their dedicated Hybrid classroom, and weekly field trips with multi-age peers led by the teacher. Families receive a Waldorf curriculum and all the high-quality supplies needed to deliver grade-specific lessons to their student.
