Dear Gladys Wood Families,

It's hard to believe we are already halfway through September. Thank you for continuing to follow our procedures for drop off and pick up. The Gladys Wood PTO was kind enough to create a map for us all to show exactly how drop off and pick up work at Gladys Wood. Last year they helped purchase the student crosswalk sign and lane signs that are put out every school day morning by our BPO and collected up by our night custodian and the Municipality of Anchorage also just completed an update on our sidewalk ramps and the clear marking of the cross walk on 69th Ave. Please take a close look at the map and make sure you're only allowing your child to get out in the designated areas to keep everyone safe.

Document Updates: If you have important confidential court documents that pertain to the custody of your children that limits who can pick your child up, please let us know. Sometimes changes occur and contact lists are inaccurate. We rely on you to let us know if someone needs to be removed from the contact list you originally created at the beginning of the school year. If you have a new phone number or person you need added to your child's contact list just call us at 742-6760 and we can get it updated.

Across the Anchorage School District we take safety concerns seriously. We teach the students here at Gladys Wood that if they see something dangerous and harmful to say something. It's a catchy phrase! If you see something, say something! Thank you for encouraging your children when they see something anywhere, including online, that's going to hurt someone to immediately say something to the adults in their lives at home and at school.

As the beautiful liquid sunshine days continue, please know you're welcome to visit the Gladys Wood playground with proper social distancing and supervision. Students are encouraged to have an adult join them for everyone's safety. Thank you also for being mindful, safe and respectful of others while visiting the playground.

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Morning Drop-Off at Gladys Wood Elementary

At Gladys Wood Elementary we want everyone to stay safe! This includes morning drop-off. While navigating through parking/drop areas, please be aware of your surroundings. There are TWO lanes as you enter Gladys Wood: **Drop and Go** (right) and the **Thru Lane** (left) to get to the parking lot. Please <u>DO NOT</u> park in the **Drop & Go** lane to take your child to their class line, this backs up the drop off process. Please use the parking lot. Please <u>DO NOT</u> stop in the **Thru Lane** to drop your child off to cross in front of the **Drop & Go** lane. It is a safety hazard. Lastly, please utilize crossing guard areas to cross the two lanes of traffic. Let's all work together to make drop-off a safe place for the kids at GW! Thank you!

BENEFITS OF FLU VACCINATION

- Getting a flu shot is more important than ever, but it does not protect against COVID-19
- It's especially important if you have heart disease, diabetes, pulmonary or other chronic diseases, are pregnant, immunocompromised or over 50.
- * The vaccine may make your illness milder if you do get sick.
- Flu vaccination may reduce the risk of serious flu outcomes, like hospitalization.

VACCINE INFORMATION

- The standard and high doses are quadrivalent: designed to protect against four different viruses.
- They do not contain latex or thimerosal.
- The high dose vaccine (for people 65+) will NOT be available at the drive-thrus.
- There are many flu viruses. The vaccine protects against those believed to be most common and is updated each year.
- You cannot get the flu from the vaccine.
