


PEAKS Assessment April 5th – April 16th


The Performance Evaluation for Alaska's Schools (PEAKS) are content area summative assessments designed to measure a student's understanding of the skills and concepts outlined in the Alaska English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics Standards and the K-12 Science Standards for Alaska. Alaska's standards are the expectations for growth in students' skills across grades. Our secondary students at Klatt Elementary School, grades 3 through 6, will be participating in PEAKS assessment April 5th through April 16th. Please send your child to school well rested during these two weeks. If your student misses a portion of the assessment, make up dates will be during the week of April 19th.




ASD Summer School
