If your family is hesitant and unsure about returning to face-to-face learning there are two options available for families. 





## Car Drop-off/Pick Up Loop

Arrival and Dismissal procedures have changed to improve overall safety during these high traffic times. Please understand that as you enter the car pick-up loop, the line will be continuously moving in a single lane along the loading zone. Vehicles will be guided through the loop by staff on duty. Staff will be wearing bright-colored safety vests and will aid in the vehicle movement through the drop-off/pick-up loop. There is no parking permitted within the drop-off/pick-up loop. Vehicles will stop only to actively unload or load students, and then they will proceed through the loop. At the loading zone, students will exit and enter vehicles from the passenger side only. The first row of the parking lot will be closed to access at the entry of the car loop. Those who wish to park may loop around and find a spot in row 2, or enter at the opposite end of row one to park. After passing the loading zone, vehicles will be guided to continue through the loop to the exit. If your child is not present at the loading zone, you will be encouraged to proceed through the loop and re-enter it at the start again, to make a second pass through the loading zone. Please bear with us, as this is a change, but keep in mind that the safety of our students is number one, and following this procedural guidance for arrival and dismissal time helps ensure all Klatt students are safe.
