## FROM YOUR PRINCIPAL

Dear Klatt Families,

It's hard to believe but another school year is just about behind us. I would like to thank all of you for supporting our school, volunteering throughout the year, and taking the time to help in the education of our students.

Looking forward to our 2019-2020 year, returning Klatt students can **register online now** and until August 23<sup>rd</sup>—registering your student as soon as possible is greatly appreciated! Register on the Q ParentConnection site at the Anchorage School District website. If you need help with the registration process, please call the office. We are happy to reset your PIN and Password if you have misplaced this information. Our goal is to have more students register during this time so we can better plan for the next school year. Last year approximately 20 percent of our students registered in the spring and we would like to see that number greatly increased.

New-to-district students or students moving over the summer to a new school zone, will need to register in person at the school they will be attending. Please come to Klatt during our three-day registration period which will be:

Tuesday, July 30<sup>th</sup> – 9 AM to 3 PM,

Wednesday, July 31 – 9AM to 3 PM and also from 5 to 7 PM,


Thursday, August 1 – 9 AM to 3 PM

We will have stations set up with computers for registering returning students. Staff will also be able to assist with resetting

ParentConnection PIN and passwords. New-to-district students (including all kindergarteners) are required to submit the following documents at registration: proof of residency (utility bill, lease or real estate contract), birth certificate (a copy is acceptable), current immunization records, names and phone numbers of emergency contacts/individuals who may pick up your child from school.

Our annual back-to-school evening will be on Monday, August 19. At that time, you can find your new teacher's name and enjoy a snow cone. The first day of school for students in grades one through six will be Tuesday, August 20<sup>th</sup>. The first day of school for kindergarten students will be the following week on Tuesday, August 27<sup>th</sup>.

I would like to acknowledge our 6<sup>th</sup> grade students that are moving on to middle school and wish them the best of luck next year. I hope everyone has a great summer break. We look forward to seeing you again in the fall!

Es difícil de creer pero otro año escolar ya está por culminar. Me gustaría agradecerles a todos por apoyar a nuestra escuela, por ser voluntarios durante todo el año y tomarse el tiempo para ayudar en la educación de nuestros estudiantes, sus hijos.

Para el próximo año escolar 2019-2020, los estudiantes que regresan a Klatt pueden ya inscribirse en línea/on line empezando hoy hasta el 23 de Agosto. Se agradece mucho que registre a su estudiante tan pronto como sea posible! Regístrese en el sitio Q ParentConnection en el sitio web del Distrito Escolar de Anchorage. Si necesita ayuda con el proceso de registro, llame a la oficina o al 907-538-3063. Si no tiene o si su PIN y contraseña se han perdido, nosotros podemos proveer otra. Nuestra meta es que más estudiantes se registren durante este tiempo para poder planificar mejor para el próximo año escolar. El año pasado, aproximadamente el 20% de nuestros estudiantes se registraron en la primavera y nos gustaría ver que este número aumentara más este año.

Tendremos estaciones listas con computadoras para registrar a los estudiantes que regresan. El personal también podrá ayudarlo a restablecer el PIN y las contraseñas de ParentConnection. Los estudiantes nuevos en el distrito (incluyendo todos los estudiantes de kindergarten) deben presentar los siguientes documentos al momento de la inscripción: comprobante de residencia (recibo de servicios públicos, contrato de arrendamiento o bienes raíces), certificado de nacimiento (se acepta una copia), registros actuales de inmunización, nombres y Números de teléfono de contactos de emergencia / personas que pueden recoger a su hijo de la escuela.

Nuestra noche anual de regreso a la escuela será el lunes 19 de agosto. En ese momento, puede encontrar el nombre del maestro de su hijo/a y disfrutar de un helado. El primer día de clases para los estudiantes de 1ro a 6to grado será el martes 20 de agosto. El primer día de clases para los estudiantes de kindergarten será la semana siguiente el martes 27 de agosto.

## Anchorage Bike Helmet Project

The Alaska Fire Department continues their partnership with Safe Kids Alaska to support the municipal ordinance requiring bike riders aged 15 and under to wear helmets on public pathways and roadways. Families are welcome to stop by the fire station to have children fit with helmets. Provided at no cost to children and teens aged 15 and under, they must be present to be fit with a helmet. The bike helmet supply is limited to stock on hand (the station on Southport has a supply). Please remember, this project is designed to assist families with limited resources that need to obtain bike helmets for their children.



## May Topic Elementary Health

This month in Elementary Health your child will study physical fitness. They will learn that muscles like to exercise—exercise not only makes them stronger, it makes the whole body feel good!

For your child's health, get him or her to engage in physical activity this summer in their daily routine. They should get one hour or more of moderate to vigorous physical activity every day. Also, make sure to limit computer games and TV time—they are the biggest factor that leads toward sluggishness. Numerous studies have shown that there is a direct correlation between a child's fitness level and the hours of TV he or she watches. Children who are watching TV are not exercising!

Beginning good health habits that includes regular exercise during the elementary school years is the best way of getting children to continue these habits through adulthood.
