



The Moose Family

An artist named Mauricio Robalino wanted to make an representational sculpture of moose. Instead of realistic moose, he wanted them to have an abstract quality. He used a laser to cut steel into shapes. Then, he bent the

steel and bolted the pieces together. Robalino named the sculpture <u>The Moose Family</u>. In 2002, the Anchorage School District bought <u>The Moose Family</u> from Robalino for \$55,000 and installed it infront of Baxter Elementary. The red, blue, and yellow moose still hang out there today. If we treat the The Moose Family with care and do not play on it, we can continue to enjoy it for years to come.

ART Rules: Apply yourself to the task at hand.

How often? How graded?

Elementary students attend up to two 1-hour art sessions per month, due to the art teacher's rotating schedule between schools. That means there are around four art sessions per quarter. Students begin earning a grade for each art session starting in First Grade. The average of these grades shows on the quarterly report card. Grades are based on student effort, the physical and mental energy put into the task at hand. Student behavior affects effort. Below are the five letter grades with possible descriptors of how students earn each one.


