Delivery Options for ESY Services

ESY services are delivered in either an itinerant model or a site-based model. Online options are also available for itinerate and site-based models.

□ Itinerant services or □ Site-based services

Itinerant services

- o Itinerant related services (e.g.: speech-language, occupational therapy) are provided at the ESY sites. Services provided by a Teacher or TA will be provided at specified community locations around Anchorage and Eagle River to accommodate families.
- o Your student's ESY provider will contact you by June 4 to coordinate details regarding locations and time of services. If you have not heard from them by June 4, please contact the Special Education District Office at (907) 742-6065.

Site-based services

- o There are two options for families for site-based ESY. All students requiring site-based services are given a 7-week term. However, parents/guardians may opt for a 4-week term (June only).
- o Site-based services are morning (8:30-11:00 am) or afternoon (1:00-3:30 pm) sessions; Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. If a particular session is required, please be sure to alert your student's special education teacher. Special Education will attempt to accommodate requests. Also consider your choice of in-person or online services.

Transportation information (bus routes, times, etc.) is finalized the week before the ESY session starts. You will be contacted via robocalls from the ASD Transportation Department with this information. If you have not heard from Transportation by June 4, please contact them at (907) 742-1200, option 5.

Class rosters and teacher assignments are also finalized the week before the ESY session starts. Your student's ESY provider will contact you by June 4.

- Please make sure that your contact information is current with your student's school as communication regarding ESY will be sent through robocalls and personal phone calls.
