# ASD High School Summer School 2019

## Who may attend?

Anchorage School District high school students in grades 9 through 12 may attend summer school. Enrollment in classes is limited to ASD high school students who failed a semester class and need to earn a passing grade. Summer session will last 4 weeks and students may sign up for an AM class, a PM class, or both AM and PM classes.

## Dates for Summer School

First day of class	May 29 <sup>th</sup>
Last day of class	June 26 <sup>th</sup>

## How much credit may be earned?

It is possible to earn 0.5 credits for each summer course.

## How long are the classes?

AM session: 8:15 a.m. - 11:15 a.m.

PM session: 11:45 a.m. - 2:45 p.m.

Classes are Monday through Friday every week from May 29<sup>th</sup> through June 26<sup>th</sup>.

## What about transportation?

Transportation to and from summer school is the responsibility of the parent/student. Students with a valid 2018-19 Student ID will be allowed to ride the People Mover Bus until June 30, 2019

## What is the cost?

Each class costs \$100. See payment options above and below. Fee waivers are available based on family income.

## Are school meals provided?

Breakfast and Lunch will be served at East and Bartlett High School.

## What classes are available?

Classes are available for English, math, social studies, science, and some electives. Classes will be online in an APEX computer lab.

## Grades

Final passing grades will be sent to the district registrar and will posted on academic transcripts. All grades will be available in mid-August.

- Having excessive absences
- Being involved in a fight
- Possession of drugs/alcohol
- Use of drugs/alcohol
- Possession of a weapon
- Found stealing or cheating
- Smoking on campus
- Being uncooperative
- Abusive language
- Disruptive behavior
- Violation of Safety Rules

Depending on the seriousness of the infraction, other consequences may be pursued (for example: expulsion, police involvement).

**How do I register?**

1. Fill out the registration form, indicating which classes you will take.
2. Have your parent/guardian sign the registration form. Parent/guardian signature is required.
3. Fee is \$100 per course.  
\*Payment can be made online via Parent Connect. See directions below. Refunds must be filed by 9/1/19.  
\*Payment can be taken to your school's Financial Procurement Office(AAFP). Make checks and money orders payable to *Anchorage School District*.  
\*Fee waivers are available and are based on family income.

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- 1) Log in to Parent Connect <https://parentconnect.asdk12.org/>  
(if you need your log-in info, please call your student's school)
  - 2) select "online payments" at the top right side of screen
  - 3) select student, if you have more than one in the district
  - 4) choose **SUMMER SCHOOL** or **iSchool** on the Selection menu
  - 5) add to cart, proceed to checkout and add credit card
  - 6) print out receipt & attach to registration form
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4. Take your receipt (either from online payment or from the AAFP) or the completed fee waiver form when meeting with your counselor to go over your completed application.
5. Your school counselor will enroll and schedule you in your summer school class(es).

**Note** – If you do not complete the registration process before the regular school year is over, you will still have an opportunity to register at your summer school site on **Tues., May 28<sup>th</sup> from 8a.m. to 1p.m.**

Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. If you wait until the last day to register, you may not be able to enroll in the class(es) that you need; the classes may be full. Classes are subject to consolidation or cancellation due to low enrollment.
