

Birchwood ABC Birchwood Advisory Committee (BAC) Fact Sheet

1. What is the BAC?

The BAC is a board of parents/guardians of current students at Birchwood ABC who have been voted by their fellow parents/guardians to represent them in matters of curriculum and philosophy at Birchwood ABC.

2. How does the BAC work with the Birchwood ABC staff to uphold the curriculum standards that have been set?

The BAC assists in interviewing teacher applicants and gives input on who they feel would be the best fit for Birchwood ABC. The BAC also works in conjunction with BAC staff when curriculum changes are presented by the school district or Birchwood ABC teachers. The goal of both the Birchwood ABC staff and the BAC is to make sure that any curriculum changes meet and exceed the standards set by the school district and will help students excel. The BAC reviews the submitted curriculum and texts along with the Birchwood ABC staff and gives recommendations on which would best fit the high standards set for Birchwood ABC.
