Last week reminded us that winter is on the way. The snow and cold will soon be upon us. Please remember that students will be outside in all types of weather during line up before school, at recess and after school when waiting for the bus or a ride. According to ASD policy students are expected to go outside for recess to a chill factor of -10 degrees. Therefore, please make sure that your child or children are properly equipped. Please see below for the expected winter gear for each grade level:

- K-3 Winter coat, hat or hood, gloves or mittens, snow pants and winter boots
- 4-6 Winter coat, hat or hood, gloves or mittens and winter boots

Other things to consider:

- A hoody is not considered suitable for outdoor winter activities
- A physician's note is necessary to exclude a student from participating in outdoor activities.

Hello Birchwood ABC Families and Friends!

Box Tops For Education is up and running again this year in the Music Room with two fabulous ways to earn: physical and digital Box Tops! Not only are there lots of products that have Box Tops on the package, now you can scan your receipt into the Box Tops app and it will do the work for you! Here's how it works:

- Buy participating products.
- Bring physical Box Tops to the Music Room and use the Box Tops mobile app to scan your store receipt.
- The app identifies eligible products and automatically adds Box Tops to your designated school's earnings online.
- Even if you're shopping online or doing grocery pickup, you can still submit your digital or email receipt and earn Box Tops. Twice a year, our school gets a check!

\*\*I've discovered that there's another way to scan digital/online receipts instead of emailing them in to BTFE - take a screenshot of your receipt, share it to another device (computer, laptop, another phone, etc), then open the BTFE app on your phone and scan the receipt from the other device like you would a physical receipt!\*\* If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to get in touch! I'm happy to help answer questions, talk you through processing online/digital receipts, tech questions, etc.

Your earnings may seem small, but they really do add up. The more people that participate, the bigger the impact we can make. Little by little, we can help make a big difference!

# **GYM SHOES!**

As students begin changing into boots, please remember to slip those shoes into backpacks for PE if your child does not already have a pair here.

### 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Skill Assessments

The Anchorage School District requires skill assessments of students in grades 4<sup>th</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup>. That means these students will receive 2 grades in PE, one for effort and one for achievement which is the skill grade. Most are physical skill assessments related to throwing, volleying, foot dribble playing defense etc. Students who show an understanding of the skill and try their best at this skill receive a satisfactory grade for that skill. A higher grade would require the student to be able to perform that skill with some success.

To assist students who may not possess some of the physical skills, an personal/social behavior or knowledge based assessment is given each quarter which is also a part of the ASD PE curriculum. **\*BONUS\*** 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade students receive an additional grade for submitting Healthy Future Activity Log. If completed correctly, it's an extra "O" in the grade book! *There is no penalty for not submitting*. September Healthy Futures Activity Logs DUE by Oct. 5th
