A note from Mrs. Frazier and Mrs. Patterson,

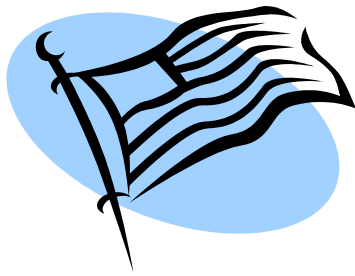

SPELLING STARTS THIS WEEK!

- Use the pink sheet to practice the first 7 words on the side that says "Monday".
- Fold the first column and dictate the first 7 words, with markings. Discuss the rules. (Do not write the rules.)
- Fold to see the second column and do the same thing.
- Practice one more time using the third column. Fold so your child cannot see the words they spelled. In the third column, spell just like you would see in a book. No markings.
- Keep the "Rules: Spelling List 1A" sheet at home to review. This is exactly what will be on the test.



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- Homework will be each night, Monday through Thursday. Please read the top of the columned paper each night for instructions. The test will be on Friday, unless there is a short week. (I will let you know if there is NOT a test for the week.) There will be a sentence dictated on the Friday test as well.

Our first book order is going home today. Please return it by Friday. Any points I get will be used to buy books for the classroom.
