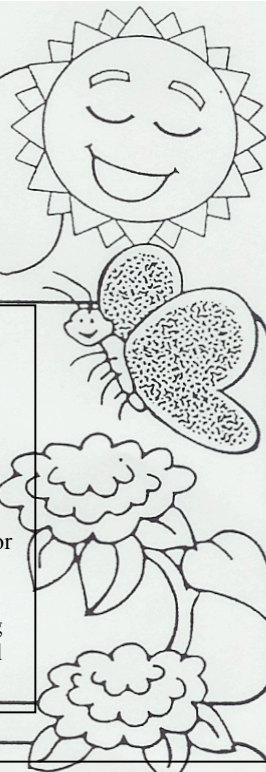


Class Update

Shoes, Socks, Tights, and Leggings

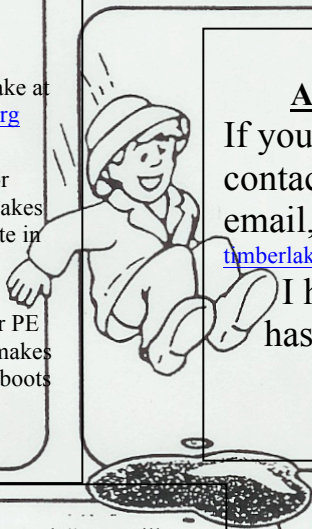

We will be reading the story, "Come Back, Jack." We will discuss the text structure and author's purpose. Our focus will be on compare & contrast and text structure.

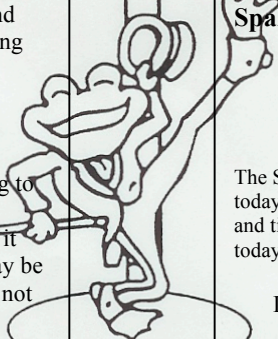
Quality Literature lessons will include precise lang., emotional appeal, insight, universality, and content. Spelling homework will start next week. There will be handwriting this week.

Science

We will be studying "Matter" this week. Solids, liquids and gases will be our focus. Investigations will include changing matter. We will start a unit on Sound, Heat and Light.

Saxon Math 3

Math lessons for the week will include writing 2 digit numbers, time to the half hour, commutative property of addition, addition fact: +0, +1, and doubles, and measuring to the nearest inch. Homework will be coming home nightly Monday-Thursday. Parents need to check homework, and it needs to be brought back to school the next day. There may be math worksheets that come home on Friday, but these are not homework. Please use them as extra practice.
