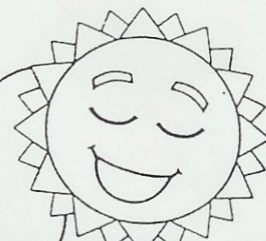


Class Update

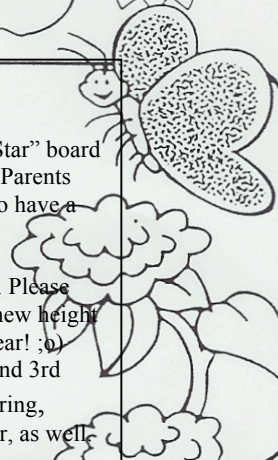
Star of the Week

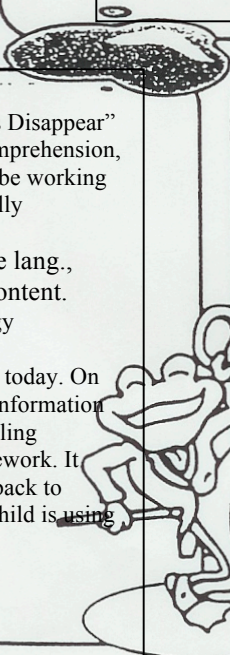
Language Arts
