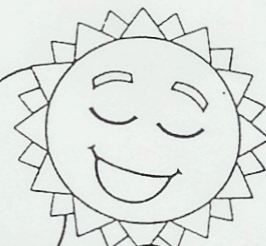


Class Update

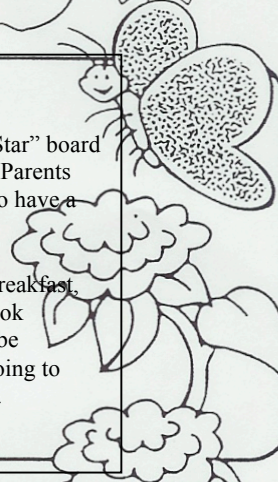
Star of the Week

Language Arts

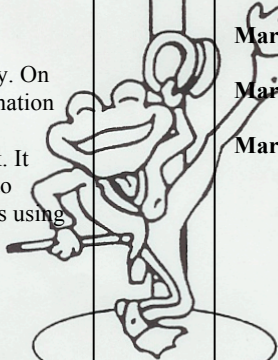
We will be working on reading passages using reformatting and mentally summarizing to find the implied main idea with notetaking.
