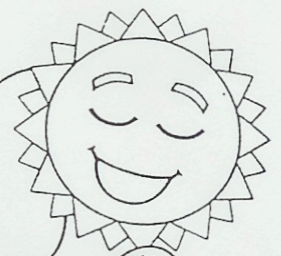


Class Update

Saxon Math 3
