Dear Parents,

The ASD has announced their plan to gradually bring kids back into schools. **In-person classes will resume on October 19 for Pre-K – Grade 6. All students will attend school 5 days a week for 5.5 hours each day. There will be no alphabet-based cohorts. The school day will begin at 9:30 am and end at 3:00 pm. Students will be required to wear a mask.** If you do not have a mask, the school will provide one. If you have questions about the masks, please get in touch with Mr. Christal or Nurse Lillian.

ASD's planning and decision-making process for determining the District's risk level for conducting school takes multiple community factors into consideration.

In recent months, the CDC has expanded their guidance and resources to help us safely educate students. This new information includes a range of metrics and other criteria that allows districts to revise and adapt school opening plans based on the unique context of their community.

While the number of new cases within the community has been and remains a key indicator, the new guidance provides districts greater latitude to adapt and revise school plans that consider not only the rate of community spread, but the ability to incorporate multi-step mitigation strategies.
