Please **Label** these supplies with your child's name:

- Backpack
- Gym Shoes: non-marking soles (Velcro tabs if needed) (If you send shoes with laces, please make sure your child **can tie them independently**.)
- Classroom Shoes: soft-soled, closed-toed shoes
- Lunchbox
- Crayons
- Erasers
- Scissors: kid-sized, pointed
- Black Dry-Erase Marker (for use later in the year)
- Yellow, Thin Highlighter (for use later in the year)
- Supply Box: plastic, to fit pencils & crayons [Please do not send metal pencil boxes. They are very loud.]
- Binder: 1 inch is preferred
- Pocket Folder (1)
- headphones for Chromebook/Comp. Lab in labeled zip bag, please
- Small container with money for math: *see back for coins needed*.
Your child must be able to open this container independently.
- Emergency Kit: *see back for contents*
- Set of Winter Outside Gear name/initial **labeled** (winter coat, boots, snow pants, gloves, and hat)
- \$5.00 for "Scholastic News" magazine (cash, or checks made out to Scholastic, please.)
- Water bottle

Please do **not label** the following supplies, as they are *shared* supplies in the classroom:

- Tissue (1 box)
- 6-sided, #2 pencils (a few)
- Red Pencils (2)
- Snack Crackers: 1 now, 1 after the new year - no peanut items please
- Last Name A-B: band aids: kid-size preferred
- Last Name C-F: quart size FREEZER zip bags
- Last Name F-H: an additional box of tissues
- Last Name K-L: extra erasers
- Last Name M-S: Sanitizing Wipes
- Last Name T-Z: gallon size FREEZER zip bags

(Glue Sticks and Liquid glue are a shared supply and I happen to already have a plethora of them.)

Emergency Kits

We ask families to supply individual emergency kits for their child. Parents are asked to treat these as necessary school supplies. This will allow for correct sizing of clothing items and give students the comfort of having their own personal items in an emergency. These kits will only be used in a community emergency such as an earthquake. Students will not be allowed to dig items out of them on an individual basis.

Please place the items in a Ziploc bag marked with your child's name.

Hat

Gloves or mittens – 1 pair

Underwear – 1 pair

Granola bar – 2

Toothbrush

Toothpaste – travel size please

Hand warmers / heat packs – optional

Picture of your family – optional (for your child's emotional comfort)

In an emergency, we want to be as prepared as possible. Thank you.
