### ONLINE COURSE REQUEST INSTRUCTIONS .....

- 1. Log in to your Student Connection account.
- 2. If you have two tracks (i.e., your main school and King Tech), select the South 2023-2024 track for your main school.
- 3. Select the "Requests" tab on the left side menu.
- 4. Click the "Add/Edit Requests" on the top right side of the section.
- 5. The course list window will appear below. When a course is selected, there will be a course description to the right (not all courses will have a description).
- 6. **Select** the course that is your first choice, then click "Add Selected Class" (Remember that the order in which you select your courses will delegate the priority of your choices).
- 7. Continue with step 6 until you have entered all of your choices in order, then click the "Submit" button at the top of the window.
- 8. You will be able to make changes to your requests only through the open registration window:
