SOUTH'S ONLINE COURSE REQUEST INSTRUCTIONS for 2020/2021:

You will have access to upload your course requests online only during the designated window: 8th graders selecting Freshman courses Tuesday 3/23 through Friday 4/9

- 1. Log in to your Student Connection account.
- 2. If you have two tracks (i.e., your main school and King Tech), select the South 2021-2022 track for your main school.
- 3. Select the "Requests" tab on the left side menu.
- 4. Click the "Add/Edit Requests" on the top right side of the section.
- 5. The course list window will appear below. When a course is selected, there will be a course description to the right (not all courses will have a description).
- 6. Select the course that is your first choice, then click "Add Selected Class" (Remember that the order in which you select your courses will delegate the priority of your choices).
- 7. Continue with step 6 until you have entered all of your choices in order, then click the "Submit" button at the top of the window.

REQUESTING COURSES ONLINE: You can go in anytime during your window to make changes. When the window closes, you will no longer have access to request your courses online, but can email your counselor directly to make updates.
