Grades K - 5 through ASD Virtual Program utilizes the following learning platforms supported by ASD virtual teachers and led by parent engagement. Courses use a variety of e-textbooks, interactive websites, and project-based learning.

The ASD Virtual K-5 program utilizes

- [Calvert Learning](#) - Calvert learning is the core program used by ASDV and is known for its academic rigor and engaging approach that improves student performance.
- [Exact Path](#) - Exact Path is used to create a personalized learning path for grades K–5 in reading, language arts, math, and to supplement Calvert Learning.
- [Suite 360](#) - Suite360 offers short weekly lessons to help students develop skills to:
 - Understand and manage emotions
 - Set and reach positive goals
 - Have and show empathy toward others
 - Build and maintain positive relationships
 - Make responsible choices
