PE - 1.5 credits required

*Each season of a school sport gives a .25 PE Waiver. Two PE waivers are needed to check off one .5 credit box. If PE waivers are used, the same number of boxes will need to be added in the elective rows. PE waivers do not grant credit, but rather waive the PE requirement.

Elective - 7 credits required

If you take more than the required credits for Eng, math, sci, soc, or PE, add those credits to the elective boxes.

22.5 total credits are required for graduation

- Be sure to enter ERHS's code
 (020368) when you sign up for the SAT/ACT. This allows your scores to be sent to the school district.
 (Required for APS)

-Letters of Recommendation-

- If you would like to request a letter of recommendation, please complete the "Request for Letter of Recommendation" form and submit it to the requested author.
 - Printable Link HERE
 - Check with the person you are requesting a letter from, because they may have their own process or form they prefer.
- Make sure to allow enough time (usually 2 weeks) for recommenders to write your letter. Plan ahead now!





-College

- Agrey down the schools you want to apply to
 - If you are not able to visit prospective schools in person, check out the many <u>virtual tours</u> available online!
- Look at application deadlines and requirements
 - Plan ahead deadlines are often late November, early December.
- If asked by the college/university, it is a good idea to waive your right to see counselor/teacher recommendations (FERPA waiver).
- If you apply through Common App/Send EDU/or other similar site, please let your counselor know...so we can make sure your recommendations are complete.

 - <u>ANY</u> student requesting aid OR receiving a scholarship should complete the FAFSA.


-Scholarships-

ALASKA PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST




To receive the APS and other forms of financial aid, students must complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by **June 30th** of each year. **Visit studentaid.gov**



Contact your counselor for information about APS courses. Approved courses may also be available through resources such as the University of Alaska or others. Eligibility is determined based upon courses with a letter grade reflected on your official high school transcript.

Choose from option A, B, or C (curriculum options apply for all APS award levels)



Highlighted sections above reflect additional course substitutions within each Curriculum Option. For example, in Curriculum Option A, two (2) Science credits may be substituted with 2 credits/years of rigorous additional non-standard Science course(s).



ALASKA PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP

- Up to \$28,000!
- Great Plan A or B
- Available for 8 years after graduation
- No competition you only need to complete eligibility requirements and the FAFSA to earn the scholarship
- Qualify by completing required classes and earning a high enough GPA or test score
- Can be used at universities and many technical and training programs in Alaska (<u>see list here</u>!)

-Western Undergrad Exchange (WUE)-

- The Western Undergrad Exchange is a wonderful opportunity for students to attend out of state school for reduced tuition costs.
- Check the <u>WUE website</u> for a complete list of participating colleges/universities.
- Check individual colleges/universities for WUE guidelines, deadlines, and requirements (schools have the freedom to alter their awarding policies and procedures)



- If you are planning to play a division I or II college sport, please make sure you have completed the requirements of the NCAA Clearing House.


