

GOVERNMENT HILL SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST FOR 2024-2025

****All Classes/All Grade Levels/All Programs****

- 1 box latex free bandaids
- 1 pair of computer headphones (no earbuds)
- 1 pair PE shoes with non marking soles to be left at school
(if your child cannot tie their own shoes, please consider velcro shoes)

- 1 backpack/book bag to transport school work- no wheels
- 2 boxes of facial tissues- 50 count or larger
- Snow Gear: jacket, snow pants, hat, gloves, boots
- 1 container of cleaning wipes (no bleach)

PRE-ESCOLAR

- 1 box of snacks to share (graham crackers, goldfish or chips)
- 1 yellow folder made of plastic (not paper) with pockets inside on both sides
- 2 packages of wet wipes
- 2 small jars of play doh (any color)
- 1 roll of black or gray duct tape
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 regular size bottle of liquid glue

KINDERGARTEN

Please do not label items unless it is specified

- 1 box of wet wipes
- 1 composition notebook
- 2 boxes of pencils (ticonderoga pencils preferred)
- 2 boxes of crayons 24 count (crayola preferred)
- 1 box of color pencils (crayola preferred)
- 3 packages of glue sticks (Elmer's preferred)
- 1 kids water bottle Visibly **Labeled**
- 1 set of extra clothes (pant, shirt, underwear and socks) visibly **labeled** with your child's name and put in a Ziplock gallon bag

- 1 pack of dry erase markers-EXPO brand preferred (not fine tip)
