## Letter of Agreement between the Anchorage School District and Anchorage Education Association

The Anchorage School District ("District") and the Anchorage Education Association ("AEA") agree to the following:

By May 1st, 2025, a District committee shall be formed and meet to review parent-teacher conference scheduling at the Elementary level.

AEA may appoint up to 12 members, primarily those teaching grades K-3 who are affected by the Alaska Reads Act. Up to 12 other non-AEA members will be assigned to the committee by the Chief Academic Officer (CAO) or his or her designee.

The District and AEA agree to the following objectives and parameters:

- 1. The committee is tasked with developing a proposal(s) to address the existing challenges with the way parent conferences are structured at the Elementary level.
- 2. The committee will meet May-August, which includes work during the summer months, traditional time off for AEA members.
- 3. AEA members on the committee will receive half a Range 1 addenda in recognition of work to be completed outside of the normal work day and year (approximately 20 hours).
- 4. The committee will present their proposal(s) to the CAO no later than August 29, 2025.
- 5. If approved by the CAO, Elementary principals will be in-serviced on the new model and trained on how to develop parent/teacher conference schedules under the new guidance.
