To finish off black history we are going to talk about sports. Marlin the Magician Briscoe was the first black starting quarterback in NFL history when the Denver Broncos drafted him in the 14th round of the 1968 NFL Draft. Briscoe's first pass was a 22-yard completion. On the second series, he led an 80-yard touchdown drive as he ran the final 12 yards for the score. As a rookie, Briscoe had 14 touchdowns, 13 picks and 1,589 yards. He played eight more seasons in the AFL and the NFL, but he was switched to being a wide receiver, being selected as a 1970 All-Pro.
