The 2022 AP Exam period is May 2-13, and the schedule for each exam is below.

Remember that **EXAM TIMES FOR ALASKA** are **7:00am** and **11:00am**.

**\*\* All AP Biology students will be taking the late Biology exam on Thu, 5/19, at 11AM, since the regularly scheduled exam conflicts with South's graduation.**

**DEADLINE** The registration window for AP Exams is from Friday, Oct 1, through Friday, Oct 29. Register ON TIME. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Do not wait until the last minute or request an extension.

**COST** Each exam costs \$96; AP Research costs \$144. Pay for all of your exams at the same time through Parent Connect. If you are taking AP US Govt and/or AP Micro 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, there will be a separate window in February to register for those. Unlike College Board's exceptions last year for COVID, **there are NO REFUNDS this year for any reason after you have paid.**

**LOCATIONS** All exams will be at South, with most in the library. Once we have final numbers and approach time for testing, you will receive more specific details about where you will be testing. At this time, College Board anticipates all tests being paper/pencil and in-person.

**BRING** #2 wooden pencils (do NOT use mechanical) with erasers  
Pens with black or dark blue ink  
Approved calculators (for exams that require them) w extra batteries

**DO NOT BRING** Mechanical pencils  
Anything that beeps, prints, can make a distraction, or is prohibited in the exam room (including, but not limited, to: smart watches, smart phones, dictionaries, multiplication tables, Chihuahuas, GoPros, real estate agents, food trucks, your English teacher, tropical depressions, Tony Soprano or any of his friends, tubas, malware, and Alexa)

Be sure to read and follow the **THREE** specific instructions to complete your registration for AP Exams. If you complete only one or two of the steps by the due date, your registration will be incomplete and you will not be able to take the AP exam(s).

### ① Join your AP Classroom(s):

- Sign in to **myap.collegeboard.org** and join your class section **BEFORE** moving on to Steps 2 and 3.
- Get your **JOIN CODES** directly from your AP teacher(s):

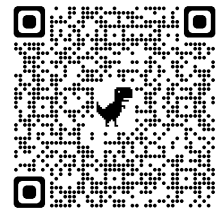

### ② PAY:

### ③ CONFIRM SPECIFIC EXAM ORDER:
