### ASD Chromebook Return Information

Elementary students attending **in-person instruction** and who have an ASD Chromebook checked out to them will be asked to return the device to their school starting **May 3**. This includes students attending inperson summer school.

Students in the **ASD Virtual program** will be asked to return their device by the end of the school year unless: 1) they are attending virtual summer school, or 2) they will be enrolled in the virtual program next year.

- Who: Every elementary student who has been issued a District Chromebook and is attending classes in-person.
- What: Students will need to return their Chromebooks and ALL power cords. Any
  Chromebooks not returned by May 7 will be remotely disabled on May 17.
- When: Chromebooks will be collected between May 3 7.

Your assistance in this process is greatly appreciated and provides a solid base for providing students with devices next fall. Returning devices now allows ASD to update and prepare them for use in your school in the 2021–22 school year.



#### **Considerations Before Applying**

ASD strives to provide opportunities for preschool students with disabilities to interact and learn with typically-developing peers. The Buddy Bear model is not intended to provide early childhood education for typically-developing children; it is designed to support the development of young children who are identified as developmentally-delayed or disabled.

A maximum of three Buddy Bears are allocated per classroom. Allocations will be determined by the principal and school team and will be reviewed throughout the school year. The number of Buddy Bear students allocated to each preschool special education class is based on the enrollment and needs of the special education students in each class. #### **Program Information**

- o Children 4-years-old on or before September 1, 2021 attend 9:45am-1:45pm, Monday-Friday
- Children younger than 4-years-old on or before September 1, 2021 attend either 9:45am-12:15pm or 1:45pm-4:15pm, Monday-Thursday
- Communication programs (Creekside, Taku, Ravenwood) operate 9:45am-12:15pm or 1:45pm-4:15pm, Monday/Tuesday or Wednesday/Thursday
- o Age Eligibility: Children must be at least 3 years old to apply
- Fee: \$200/semester; waived for families qualifying for free/reduced lunch

#### Transportation is not provided for the Buddy Bear Program.

#### **Application and Selection**

In consultation with the school team(s), principals select Buddy Bears based on program and classroom needs, and returning Buddy Bear status. Buddy Bear applicants must complete the *Buddy Bear Application*. The *Ages & Stages (ASQ) Screener* is completed by the family when contacted by a school for possible selection.

Buddy Bears must reapply each school year.

Each month Birchwood ABC focuses on a different character trait.
