- Students will show catch up growth on MAP reflective of where they were before the extended school closure.
- Any student achievement gap created by Corona will be made up for.
- We will see a 50% decrease in students not able to access Online Lang Arts & Math curricular materials

ATTENDANCE IMPROVEMENT GOAL

- Attendance data will be collected in the first week of return to school
- Over the course of the Ist quarter we will improve by 5% the daily attendance rate at Central
- We will maintain this improved attendance rate over the course of the year, regardless of whether school is in-person or online.
- We will decrease our Chronically absent student percentage rate to match the district percentage rate

SCHOOL CLIMATE MAINTENANCE GOAL

- All students will be part of an Academic Core Team
- Core teams will actively engage students to foster and build community
- Core Teams will engage in active onboarding activities
- Every student will be able to articulate which team they are a part of and what it means to be part of that team
- Parents will know what team their student is a part of
- Teams will conduct at least 3 activities per quarter that include parents
