

I WILL REACH OUT to support those who are targets of hate.


I WILL PROMOTE RESPECT for people and help foster a prejudice-free school.

ASD Bus Update

- Bussing will be inconsistent
- Look for carpooling options
- Arrive early; be patient

What Transportation Will Look Like?

- Rotating bus route scheduling similar to last year, but districtwide
- Impact will be to <u>all</u> ASD schools that receive busing services
- Special Education transportation will continue as planned for students with an IEP
- Bus Cohort Rotation
- Saturday, August 13 by 5:00 pm families will be able to see transportation status in Parent Connect
 - All bus information will be in Parent Connect only for parents—only send them here



Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up - Crysta

Due to ASD's transportation shortage, Mears will likely adjust student drop-off and pick-up locations to accommodate for more cars. Detailed information is forthcoming.

Families are encouraged to consider safe alternatives to get to school, including walking and riding a bike. Please be sure that students are appropriately dressed for cold weather and that they have reflective clothing when it gets dark. Bike riders should always wear a helmet.

Additionally, families who will be driving to school should plan on an early arrival and also consider safe alternative places in the neighborhood to drop their children off. This will help prevent bottleneck traffic in the mornings and afternoons in the campus parking lot.

- Core academic classes are the priority
- Elective courses are quite full; schedule changes will be limited

- ✓ 7th and 8th: Check for two elective courses unless you are an immersion student



Interscholastic Sports Activities


- \$110 activity fee

All forms turned in after 1:00pm will be processed the following business day


