The Anchorage School District provides transportation for students living 1.5 miles or more from their neighborhood school. Transportation is also provided for students who live within 1.5 miles of their school, but who would have to walk across or along an unsafe roadway. The school district's Hazardous Transportation Committee and the School Board have designated Boniface Parkway as an unsafe, hazardous crossing. Therefore, students who live on the bus route may not walk or ride their bikes to school. We have no way of guaranteeing that students will cross Boniface safely and, in fact, have had reports of students being narrowly missed by cars. Other areas in our attendance zone are within safe walking distance according to the Anchorage School District's guidelines.

Bussing is provided for Nunaka Valley students who live on the west side of Boniface Parkway and the area bordered by Northern Lights and Boniface. Students are expected to use the bus stop closest to their home and get on and off at their stop each day. Safe choices at bus stops and on the bus are essential for safe transport. The bus driver or the principal may assign students a seat. Some students on Individual Education Plans may also qualify for bus transport.
