*Ziplocs can be reused and/or recycled. Have your kid/s bring them home, give them a rinse, and let them dry out. Reuse or recycle at the grocery store. (Trex Decking, which is expensive, can be made with recycled plastic. It takes 140,000 ziplocs to make 500 square feet of Trex, so save those bags and recycle them and maybe we can bring the cost of composite decking down, as there is a shortage of recycled materials for manufacturing it).
