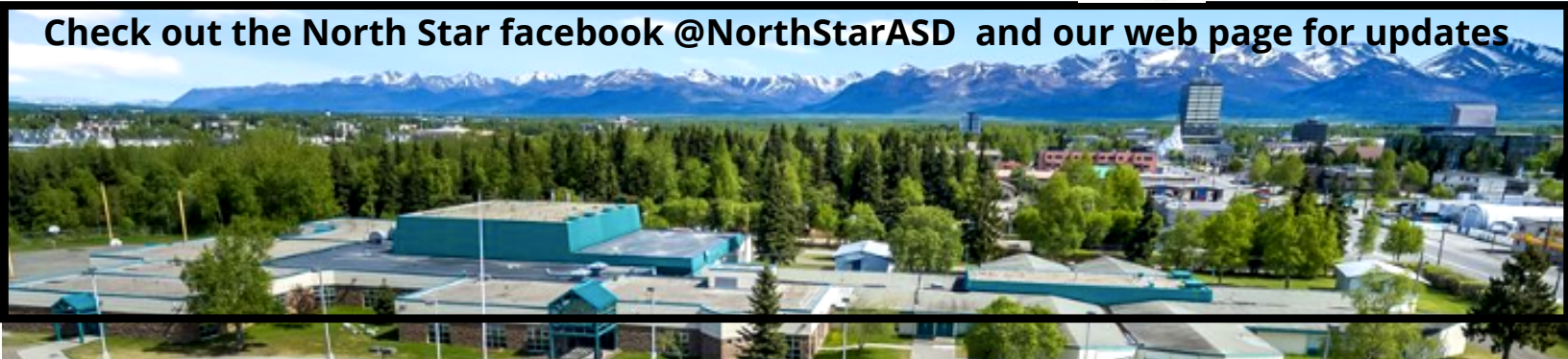

Submitting work to Canvas:

There will always be two-buttons per assignment. One button starts the assignment, and the other submits it. The first button might say "reply", submit or, "begin" once you hit it, the assignment will appear, and the student can begin. The student must scroll down to the bottom of the assignment and hit "submit" when they are done. You will know the assignment is submitted when you see confetti on the screen. If you do not hit submit and leave the screen, the work will not be saved, and the teacher will not be able to see the work completed.

What is Q:

Q is where all permanent student records are housed. You can access Q through Parent Connect using the same pin and log-in that you used for registration. Once you have logged in, you can see your student's grades and attendance.

Grades:

In order for students to receive grades, they must turn in assignments. Each teacher has posted assignments on Canvas that can be accessed by all students. Each teacher is required to take at least two grades per week in Math and ELA.

At North Star, we have been preparing for student return, so when Dr. Bishop gives the go-ahead, we will be ready. It will be important that the new procedures are followed in their entirety to mitigate the spread and help us stay healthy and safe. Things will be different here, and it will take all of us to make sure our children stay safe and healthy. Some of the changes will mean that arrival and dismissal will take more time, and families will have to prepare for that. Though it has always been our goal to make things convenient for our families, we must make sure everyone is safe this year.

Arrival:

The new school day will begin at 9:30 am. There are no morning programs, and doors will remain locked until 9:25 am. It is essential that you do not drop your child off before 9:20 am as their supervision will begin at that time and not before. I know this is an inconvenience, but we must work together to eliminate the spread of Covid-19 and make sure that all of our families and staff stay healthy and safe. Also, only students will be allowed down the hallways or past the office doors.

Dismissal:

Dismissal will begin at 2:50 pm. Students will sit next to their family on the bus. If a child refuses to sit with their family group or sits in an undesignated seat, suspension from the bus could occur. All families will be given a pick-up number. You must have your number posted in your window if you are choosing to pick-up your family. All families need to stay in their cars. Your child(ren) will be waiting for you. (in family groups. If you are the parent of a kindergarten or preschool student, pick up and drop off will occur in the back of the school. Siblings of K & PK students will be picked up in the rear of the school as well.

Classroom

In classrooms, students will be in their classroom and will stay with their classroom group all day. They will have recess each day and opportunities for movement, and safely distanced socializing. There are protocols in place to systematically clean and disinfect classrooms. Students are encouraged to bring their water bottles as the drinking fountains will be unusable. Students will be required to wear masks at all times and will wash their hands and use hand sanitizer throughout the day. 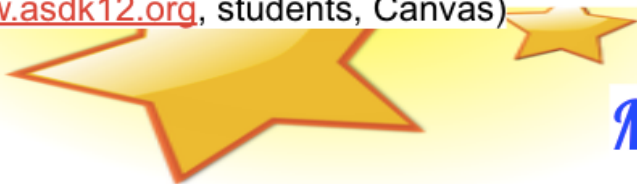
Attending school is important! Did you know that we take attendance Monday through Friday?
