2022-2023 STUDENT SUPPLY LIST**

GENERAL (All Grade Levels—Except Pre-school)

PE Shoes	1 pair	Gym shoes with non-marking soles to be left at school
Backpack	1 each	Backpack or book bag to transport school work to/from home
Tissue boxes	1 box	Facial tissues, 50-count or larger
Lunch bag	1 each	Lunch bag or box to transport school lunch to/from home
Pencils	1 box	#2 pencils
Crayons	1 box	24 or less
White glue	1 each	School glue, 4-oz bottle
Markers	1 box	8 count, wide-tipped, washable (not permanent)

Kindergarten Only

Glue sticks	12 each	Must dry clear/white
Scissors	1 pair	Blunt-tip, metal (See below)



Primary Only (1st, 2nd and 3rd grades)

Erasers	2 each	Pink
Scissors	1 pair	Blunt tip
Pocket folders	3 each	Two pockets per folder
Notebook paper (3 rd grade only)	1 pkg	Loose-leaf, 100-count (not spiral bound), wide-ruled

Intermediate Only (4th, 5th and 6th grades)

Notebook Paper	3 pkgs	Loose-leaf, 100-count (not spiral bound), wide-ruled
Binder	1 each	Three-ring (1 ½ ")
Notebook dividers	1 pkg	8 tab
Pocket folders	3 each	Two pockets per folder
Composition Book	2 each	
Colored pens	1 pkg	Any color
Ruler	1 each	12-inch with inches and centimeters
Scissors	1 pair	

Check with the individual teacher before buying the following items:

- Colored pencils
- Three-ring binder (Primary)
- Package of dividers (Primary)
- Box of pens
- Dry erase markers

Kindergarten Parents: Please check with your child's teacher before purchasing the scissors.

EMERGENCY COMFORT KIT



In the event of an emergency, and we need to keep students at school longer than the typical day, we would like each child to have a "Comfort Kit". These kits are kept in a clearly marked container in each classroom and are only used in the event of an actual emergency.

Comfort Kit items need not be new, but they should be clean. Place the following items in the attached gallon-size Ziploc bag and put the student's name on it:

- 1 pair mittens or gloves
- 1 pair socks
- 1 warm hat
- 1 pair underwear (for younger students)

Optional Items (for "extra" comfort):

- A photo of you or your family
- A note to your child

Comfort Kits will be returned to families at the end of each year.
