Mt. Spurr Ashfall Event Dismissal Plan

In the event that Mt. Spurr erupts while students are attending school, Rilke Schule will close school and notify parents to pick up their children. There would be a few modifications to our regular dismissal procedures since this would be an emergency / mass student dismissal.

- First and foremost, please <u>stay calm and patient</u> when picking up your children as we work to release nearly 500 students. This is not a life-threatening event and ash will not appear in Anchorage for a couple of hours after the eruption occurs.
- Please make sure you have a pick up <u>plan in place</u> and share it with your children in case of an ashfall event so they feel reassured during this unique event.
- Make sure your <u>approved pick up list is up-to-date</u> with the front office. We will not be releasing students to unapproved adults, and the phone lines will likely be busy.
- <u>All students</u> will be picked up in the drive through lanes, parents should <u>not park</u> and come in the building. Teachers and paras will help guide students from their classroom to their cars. Please do not come into the building so we can dismiss efficiently and effectively.
- Students will be issued masks in the case that ash is falling during dismissal.
