We are so excited to be back in school soon. You may have noticed, if you have driven by Kincaid, that our roof is currently being replaced. This project will continue after school hours once school starts and will continue through the summer next year. In the end, we will have a roof in place that no longer leaks. This will not impact students, but you will see equipment and roofing materials stored on the back half of our basketball courts.



Ms. Kelly, Ms. Sandie, Mr. Julius and I have been in the office preparing the building for staff and students and helping families register students for school. If you have not yet finalized your

First Day of School for 1st-5th Grade - August 15th

We are looking forward to seeing everyone return back to school. We encourage all families to strive to be at school by **8:45 am on Mondays**, and **7:45 am Tuesday-Friday**. This gives students enough time to get lined up, put their things away, and settle in before instruction begins right away with the bell. Students who show up as school begins miss our morning announcements, and important instructions provided by their teacher. It also creates unnecessary stress on children who feel out of sorts by being late.

On the first day of school, staff will be out helping all students find their class line. All students will line up in the front of school this year.

K-2nd will line up in front by the clock tower.

3rd-5th will be lining up in the front of school at the end of C Hall and outside the stage entrance. Staff will be available outside to help all students find their line.

All visitors who come inside the building must check in at the front office.

Kindergarten First Day of School - August 22

All Kindergarten families will schedule a family meeting with your child's teacher. These meetings will take place starting on August 15. Teachers will also offer a shortened day for students to attend a class session where the teacher can practice routines and procedures before the first day of school. You will be able to sign up for these meetings during our Popsicles and Placements on August 14th. If your are not able to attend that day, your child's teacher will call to set up an appointment to meet with you.

On August 22, the first day of Kindergarten, we invite parents to come in. You will be invited to a story time with your children and the principal, and be treated to coffee and pastries, provided by our PTA.

Kincaid reminders...

- Phones and Watches that function as a phone (texting or calling features) are turned off and stored in backpacks.
- Hats are removed upon entering class.
- We expect students to dress appropriately for weather conditions. This includes wearing long pants (no shorts) when temperatures drop below 40. Students do call home if they need winter gear, or are not dressed appropriately for the conditions.
- Always remember and practice our core values Be Kind, Respectful, Responsible and Safe Leaders.

7:50 (Teachers invite students into the building from outside classroom doors)

8:00 am Tardy Bell. (Students who arrive at this time will be late for class and may be stressed as they are missing important information and directions from their teacher)

2:30 Dismissal.

Biking to School



Families with students at Kincaid are encouraged to apply for Free and Reduced Lunches. Please include <u>all ASD students</u> in your household in the student section on the meal application, regardless of where they attend school, so we may certify your family in one application together. You may apply at any time of the year if your circumstances change due to layoffs, adding

people to your households or decreased income.

Visitors and Volunteers

If you plan to volunteer this year in the classroom or on a field trip, you are required to have an application approved with ASD. We ask that all of our volunteers fill this application out now because it can take up to 7 days to get approved. <u>Volunteer Application</u>

All visitors must stop at the front office and check in with Kelly or Sandie. Visitors may not go to a classroom unless we have contacted the teacher to let them know you are on your way. Visitors may only enter the school through the front door. If you are dropping something off for your child or for the teacher, you may leave it at the office.

Nurse Notes

Per state requirements (<u>https://www.asdk12.org/Page/7941</u>), all students in K, 1st, 3rd, 5th are given basic screenings on vision, hearing, and height/weight. All students in K, 1st, 2nd, and some in 3rd will have photoscreenings. The school nurse completes most



of the screenings in her office, and the Lion's Club completes photoscreening on site at Kincaid. Photoscreening involves looking into a small device, which is then able to determine refractive errors, eye alignment, and pupil size. This information can tell whether a child will need follow-up with an eye doctor. Each child will be sent home with a copy of their results, and nurse will send referral forms for those who qualify. This year, photoscreenings will be November 8th, and any child with glasses or contacts should have them that day to use at the screening. Please contact the nurse with any questions or concerns.

Parent Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Parking Lot

- Enter from Caravelle or Raspberry Rd.
- Drive 5 mpr
- Do Not park along the curbs. If no spot is available, circle around.
- Students must be escorted through the parking lot to the sidewalk, using our cross-walks.

Drop Off/Pick-up Lane:

• Enter the Drop Off Lane from our Raspberry Entrance.

- Drive 5 MPR
- Stay Off Cell Phones Stay alert
- Driver Must remain in the vehicle.
- Students should exit the vehicle on the curb side only.
- We have signs designating where parent pick-up and drop-off off begins and ends. We ask that you pull as far forward as you can, closing all gaps in the line.
- Our staff will help guide you. They are out there to keep our students and visitors safe. Please follow the instructions of school staff.

At the end of the day, students will wait by their grade level cone for parents. If you are in the parent pick-up line, they will be excused as soon as we see you. If you are in the parking lot, you must walk to the cones to pick your child up.
