

Hot Lunches in December

School Lunch Serviddes Dec. 9 - 13

Kincaid will not have a hot meal service December 9-13.

We will provide alternative meals. Please note the following procedures and limitations:

- 1. Student Nutrition will provide lunch. These will be in the form of **self-contained**, **shelf-stable** *lunch kit* with a **shelf-stable** milk.
- 2. During this time, the shelf stable meals will be free to students and do not need to be counted.
- 3. The menu selection is limited and unfortunately there are no accommodations for any student who is allergic to any of the included menu items. Your school nurse will need to monitor children with allergies to any of the components. Those children who cannot eat any of the components should plan on bringing lunch from home.
- 4. During the time our school is on Shelf stable meal status, *students will not be charged, and the meals will be free.*
