#### Note from the Principal

Dear Girdwood PK-8 School Families,

Happy Holidays! It is hard to believe we are in the final month of 2023, and we are almost done with the second quarter of the school year! We hope you all join us for our PTA Holiday Bazaar next Saturday, December 9th, from 12-4 pm, and our Primary Holiday Concert on December 20th at 6:30 pm. Both events are sure to bring you some holiday cheer! Our community is amazing and gives so much during this time of year! We have many programs that reflect Girdwood's caring community culture. Our students will soon be gathering canned food for our annual canned food drive that helps support local families. We will also continue our Angel Tree and hope you will reach out to brighten the holiday season for local families.

During the month of December, we are completing our winter MAP Benchmark Assessment in math and English language arts for grades 3-6 next week and mClass testing for students in grades K-3 Wednesday, 12/13. These are assessments that help us determine if students are making adequate progress. These tests are given three times a year to see how students are progressing. A large part of students making adequate growth is through good attendance in school. Please make sure that your children are in school unless they are ill. The goal for each student is to be in school 90% of the school year. That means students can only miss approximately 17 days of the entire year to reach this goal. A high attendance rate is important because students are more likely to succeed in academic and social skills when they attend school consistently. It is difficult for their teacher and the class to build their skills and progress if a large number of students are frequently absent.

Our staff is continuing to gain knowledge on the Professional Learning Community (PLC) structure and the benefits of our collaboration to our students' learning. Thank you for being flexible with our one hour late start on Mondays, which allows our teaching staff to meet each week. We have developed the following during our PLC time:

ASD and Girdwood School Mission: Educating all students for success in life.

Girdwood School Vision: Girdwood PK-8 is a school of engaged learners committed to academic excellence, who act with integrity, and are inspired by nature while rooted in community.

Collective Commitments for our Girdwood School Staff:

- Use data to inform and ensure all students are on a path for success and create data informed support for student needs.
- Utilize a variety of instructional strategies to engage and meet individual learning needs that promote growth and challenge all 2. students.
- 3. Communicate with team members and colleagues to monitor and support success strategies.
- 4. Develop and implement a writing continuum through the grade levels.
- 5. Review and respond to our school's Peer Climate and Connectedness surveys annually and then use research to inform instructional strategies that promote positive peer relationships.
- 6. Collaborate with staff and families to identify and support students with SEL needs.
- Develop and implement an effective SEL model that encourages empathy and peer respect at every grade level and across curriculums 7. and classrooms.
- Empower students to be involved in a meaningful way to promote student voice through authentic leadership opportunities at each 8. grade level.
- 9. Help students learn by doing in the greater Girdwood Community and our natural spaces through programs such as school ski days, days of service, intensives, middle school electives, wow trips, pie social, harvest potluck, travel opportunities, school garden, guest presenters, parent nights, class field trips, and supporting our Four Valleys Community School and School PTA who provide funds and opportunities for these activities.
- 10. Provide parents with resources, strategies, and information to help students succeed.

Just a few reminders for all:

- Keep up with your child's grades and assignments through accessing Q Parent Connect at any time. Do you know how to login to Q? If not, give our front office a call at 742-5300 to get your login and password.
- Winter is here, or at least it feels like it. Please send your student to school with appropriate gear and clothing. We go outside everyday rain or shine unless the temperatures are below negative 10 degrees.

Students begin winter break on December 22nd and return to school on January 8th. I hope you all have an excellent holiday season and winter break!

#### mClass Winter Benchmark ELA Assessment Family Information

As part of The Alaska Reads Act, the State of Alaska requires that districts administer an early literacy screening tool three times a year to students in grades K-3 to identify potential reading difficulties in order to improve reading outcomes for students. Families can read more about this comprehensive K-3 reading policy at The Alaska Reads Act website: <u>education.alaska.gov/akreads</u>. mClass with DIBELS 8th Edition Assessments is the State of Alaska Department of Education's and ASD's Early Literacy benchmark screening and progress monitoring tool for students in grades K-3 in reading. mClass utilizes curriculum-based measures and is used by schools as part of the ASD Comprehensive Assessment System to support informed instructional decisions. The Alaska Department of Education & Early Development explains the decision to adopt mClass as the statewide literacy screener at the following website: <a href="https://education.alaska.gov/Alaska-Reading-">https://education.alaska.gov/Alaska-Reading-</a> Resources/Statewide-Early-Literacy-Screener . mClass screening assessments will be administered in-person at Girdwood School to our K-3 students on 12/13/23. Results for K-3 students that were assessed during a benchmark window, will be available in Parent Connect by January 5, 2024. The instructions for accessing the **SORA** reading app are made available for you here. Your student will know how to access these books as their login is the same one they use for their Google Apps at school. We have also practiced this in library class.

- Access Sora from student ASD Clever accounts or install the Sora app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and select Anchorage School District and set it as MY SCHOOL or go to <a href="https://soraapp.com/library/anchorageak">https://soraapp.com/library/anchorageak</a> in your browser.
- Log in using your ASD Google Log On.
  STUDENTS: last.first@asdk12.org and the Password is the same as their Google Log On. It may prompt you to use (.net instead of .org)
- Browse the EXPLORE Tab to find an ebook or audiobook to check out. You can close the book and go to the SHELF Tab to see all the books you have checked out.
- Tap on an ebook or audiobook to start reading....
  Tap Options to renew or return the book, get to your notes and highlights, and more. Books automatically return after the set check-out time so there is no need to return it manually.



#### Dogs on the Playground


Just a reminder to keep your dogs leashed while on the playground here at school for the safety of our students and to ensure our playground remains free of dog poop.


Why join PTA? Our focus is supporting programs that help students be successful in their learning. Last year PTA funded over \$20,000 in programs and supplies for our students and school, including:
