Moose Safety

Parents—teach kids to Be KidSafe around moose:

- · Remember that moose are wild animals
- · Don't scream and run
- · Never get between a mother moose and its calf

Stay away from moose:

- Keep at least 100 feet away (2 houses) from any moose and twice as far from one with a calf
- Get behind something big if a moose comes toward you
- Avoid moose: go back home, to school, to the nearest Safe Home or find a different, safe walking route
- Don't try to pet or feed moose
- · Don't throw snowballs or objects at moose

Signs of a moose ready to attack:

It dashes around, its ears go down, it will lick its lips, and the hair goes
up on the back of its neck. You are too close if you can see all this!

Anchorage School District Fall Registration Schedule

Online Registration dates for returning ASD students: April 25th –August 14th

Although Online Registration will be open through August 14th, registering your student before August 9th is appreciated.

Have you moved? Will your children be attending a different school? You may register online, but please notify your new school as you will need to provide Proof of Municipality of Anchorage Residency to your new school. Girdwood School will reopen the week of July 29th.

ASD is offering an Online Pre-Enrollment option for those new-to-District families and former ASD students, who would prefer to enroll their students from the comfort of their home, work, or anywhere! Pre-Enrollment is open, and you can search "New-to-District Families" to access the link for registration.

New-To-District Students (including all Kindergarteners) are required to submit the following documents at Registration:

- *Proof of Municipality of Anchorage Residency, specific to Girdwood, (utility bill, lease, or real estate contract, etc.) will be verified for the following situations: new to school/new-to-district (including kindergarten) throughout the school year.
- *Birth Certificate (copy acceptable)
- *Names and phone numbers of emergency contacts and individuals who may pick up the child from school
- *Name and address of previous school attended
- *Copies of current legal papers if there is a custody agreement

The first day of school:

- *Thursday, August 15, for Grades 1-8 (Please note Girdwood School 8th grade students will be returning to school on Thursday, August 15, not Friday, August 16th, like other ASD 8th grade students.)
- *Thursday, August 22nd, for Preschool and Kindergarten



Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, May 10-12

Starting with the graduating class of 2028 (current 8th graders), Anchorage School District is introducing a comprehensive wall-to-wall career academy model, known as the Academies of Anchorage.

The Academies of Anchorage is dedicated to providing every student with career opportunities and essential workplace skills. In 9th grade, students will kick off their high school journey in a Freshman Academy, which includes a Career Exploration course designed to promote a smooth transition from middle school to high school, support academic success, and help students explore career pathways. Stay tuned for more details about Freshman Academy and the Career Academy model during upcoming transition activities with your high school.

After school, students enjoy playing with friends and classmates on the school playground. We enjoy having them here, but cannot provide outdoor supervision after 3:15 p.m. School dismisses at 3 p.m and, for safety reasons, students are expected to head for home, FVCS classes, or after school care on buses, bikes, feet or in a parent vehicles by 3:15.

Students are more than welcome to stay on the playground if they are with a supervising adult. This is true for all students, including middle school. The only exception is when students remain to participate in school or FVCS supervised activities. Thank you for your help in keeping all the children in our valley safe and supervised.


